EIU CLASSES ANNOUNCED IN RANTOUL AREA

CHARLESTON, IL---Eastern Illinois University will offer thirty classes in the Rantoul area this fall semester.

One graduate course, The Superintendent of Schools (EDA 6650-115), 4 semester hours, meets on Thursdays from 7 to 9:30 p.m. beginning August 24 in the Media Center of the Champaign/Ford Educational Service Region Building, 200 South Fredrick Street in Rantoul.

Twenty-nine graduate and undergraduate courses will be offered at Chanute Air Force Base, including the graduate course Psycho-Social Development of the Adolescent and Young Adult (EDP 5710-115), 3 semester hours, on Wednesdays from 7 to 9:30 p.m. beginning on August 23 in Jackson Hall, Room 212.

One course which may be taken for graduate or undergraduate credit includes Adult and Continuing Education Today (EDF 4998-121), 1 semester hour, one weekend from 3:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Friday and from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday, September 8-9, in Jackson Hall, Room 203. No books are needed for this course. Another course which may be taken for graduate or undergraduate credit is Contemporary America (HIS 4960-116), 3 semester hours, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on alternating Saturdays beginning August 26 at Jackson Hall, Room 214.

Sixteen undergraduate courses will be offered including The Detective in Fiction (ENG 3604-115), 3 semester hours, on Thursdays from 7 to 9:30 beginning August 24 in Jackson Hall, Room 212; Victorian Literature (ENG 3807-115), 3 semester hours, on Mondays from 7 to 9:30 p.m. beginning August 28 in Jackson Hall, Room 214; Hospitality Services Industry (HEC 3790-115), 3 semester hours, on Tuesdays from 7 to 9:30 p.m. beginning August 29 in Jackson Hall, Room 235; History of Modern Philosophy (PHI 3260-115), 3 semester hours, on Wednesdays from 7 to 9:30 p.m. beginning August 23 in Jackson Hall, Room 231; Racial and Cultural Minorities (SOC 4740-115), 3 semester hours, on Saturdays from 9 to 11:30 a.m. beginning August 26 in Jackson Hall, Room 233; Interview and Conference (SPC 3300-115), 3 semester hours, on Tuesdays from 7 to 9:30 p.m. beginning August 29 in Jackson Hall, Room 233.
