IAHPERD SOUTH EAST DISTRICT WORKSHOP TO BE HELD AT EASTERN

CHARLESTON, IL -- The South East District of the Illinois Association for Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance (IAHPERD) will hold its October workshop at Eastern Illinois University with keynote speaker Judi Sloan, 1993 Illinois Teacher of the Year.

The South East District is hosting the Oct. 4 workshop to discuss interviewing techniques with a local panel of school administrators. The workshop is open to the public.

Sloan will begin the workshop by discussing her career in education. A high school physical education teacher in Skokie, she is the first in her area of expertise to win the Illinois Teacher of the Year Award.
