CHARLESTON, IL --Solar energy for space and water heating will be among topics covered at an energy workshop at Eastern Illinois University on Saturday, May 2.

Purpose of the workshop, according to Dr. Hamid Gholamnezhad, Director of Eastern's energy management program, is to discuss the impact of energy shortages on consumers and business, and some suggested solutions.

Other topics to be covered include The United States' Energy Future: 1985-2000; Deregulation and Local Business; Energy, the President and the Congress; and Life-Cycle Costing.

Instructors, in addition to Gholamnezhad, are Dr. Lawrence Bates, Economics; Dr. Larry Thorsen, Political Science; Dr. Robert Waddell, Physics; and Dr. Sally Jo Wright, Finance.

Gholamnezhad said the workshop would be beneficial to planners, administrators, energy managers, educators, business consultants, marketing managers, farmers, financial consultants, and concerned consumers.
