The College offers a variety of undergraduate majors leading to the Bachelor of Science in Business degree, as well as a graduate program culminating in the Master of Business Administration degree.

NOTE TO THE EDITOR (Prophetstown Echo): Michelle Koehler, daughter of Arlyn and Kay Koehler of Prophetstown, is the recipient of the Exceptional Student Fellowship Award from State Farm Companies Foundation. She is the first EIU student to receive this honor. Koehler has also received a Eunice W. Dougherty Scholarship Award. This is a cash award given to juniors in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences and the Lumpkin College of Business. A cumulative grade point average of 3.85 or higher is needed to be eligible. She was also awarded the Jerome Rooke Accountancy Scholarship which is presented annually to the most

outstanding major in the junior year. The student must have earned a minimum grade point average of 3.0 overall and 3.5 on a scale of 4.0 in Accounting 2150 and Accounting 3030.

Adding to these awards, Koehler is also the recipient of the Delta Mu Delta--Junior Achievement Award, the Phi Gamma Nu--Highest Junior GPA Award, and the Student Accounting Society--Outstanding Junior Award. Koehler, a junior majoring in accounting in the spring semester, is a 1988 graduate of Tampico High School.
