CHARLESTON, IL.--Calvin Malone, Eastern Illinois University sophomore from Chicago (Marshall), is the 1986 recipient of the Martin Luther King, Jr. scholarship.

Established by Eastern's chapter of the American Association of University Professors (AAUP), the award annually goes to a student "who is a living example of the ideals and values" expressed by the late civil rights leader.

The award, presented by EIU President Stan Rives, includes a certificate and cash stipend.

Malone holds offices in the Black Student Union and has served on committees that administer Miss Black EIU Pageant, Homecoming and Parents Weekend.

He has a double major in Afro-American Studies and Sociology.
