CHARLESTON, IL. -- Eastern Illinois University's basketball Panthers will close out the pre-conference portion of their schedule hosting Augustana on Saturday (Jan 10) and Chicago State on Wednesday (Jan. 14).

All three teams have similar records. EIU is 3-5 prior to a Wednesday (Jan. 7) game with Indiana State.

Augustana is 5-5 with games vs. Millikin and Bishop (TX) University prior to the Panthers. Chicago State is also 5-5 with Eastern Washington McNeese State on the schedule before EIU.

Eastern recently snapped a five game losing streak defeating Southern Illinois, 58-57, in Carbondale. That win gives the Panthers some impetus with the three straight home games before the AMCU-8 race opens with Illinois-Chicago here on Saturday, Jan. 17.

"We'd certainly like to be back at the .500 mark when the conference race opens up," said Coach Rick Samuels, "because the way the AMCU teams have looked up to now the league is going to be ever more competitive than we imagined."

TIPOFF: Eastern Illinois University (3-5) hosts Augustana (5-5), 7:30, Saturday, Jan. 10; hosts Chicago State (5-5), 7:30, Wednesday, Jan. 14, Lantz Gym.

RADIO: All the action can be heard over 50,000 watt Mattoon WLBH-FM, 97 on the dial, with Marc Stuart and Mike Bradd calling the action.

<u>SERIES:</u> EIU leads Augustana, 2-1, winning the last meeting, 90-68 in 1985. .EIU leads Chicago State, 4-2, losing the most recent game, 92-76, last February.

COACHES: EIU's RICK SAMUELS, in his 7th year, won his 100th career victory at SIU last Saturday ... he is 100-83, same overall ... he's a former Iowa State assistant who has had five of six winning seasons ... he is 1-0 vs. Augustana, 3-1 vs. Chicago State. . . Augie's JIM LEIX is 37-25 in his third year there, 106-60 overall and 0-1 vs. EIU. ..BOB HALLBERG, in his 10th year at Chicago State, is 218-71 at CSU, 345-134 overall, and 2-4 vs. EIU.

THE VIKINGS: Augustana has a 5-5 record with games vs. Wheaton (1/6) and Bishop (TX) College (1/8) prior to EIU . . . only comparative score is Augie 83-80 loss to Millikin which beat EIU, 90-77 . . . lost to North Park, 86-70, in most recent outing . . . has four of five starters in double figures TONY TAYLOR at 19.8, BRAD STORM at 13.7, MIKE OWENS at 12.5 and DAVE STROUD at 10.4 . . . TAYLOR leads with eight rebounds p/game . . . Augustana is averaging 77.8 and allowing 75 p/game . . . STORM and OWENS are both lettermen but all five starters are new from last year.

THE COUGARS: Chicago State has had four straight 20 win seasons but to make that five in a row will have to win on the road as the EIU game is the second of nine consecutive away games for the Cougars . . . CSU is 5-5 with games vs. Eastern Washington (1/10) and McNeese State (1/12) before the Eastern contest . .the Cougars have already beaten two AMCU opponents, Illinois-Chicago (96-81) and Wisconsin-Green Bay (66-57) but did have their 75 game home court winning streak snapped by Mississippi Valley recently . . .DARREN GUEST, 6-9 transfer from Auburn, leads the team with a 17.8 average . . .SHAWN BELL, a Californian, is at 16 ppg, SHAWN BALARK is at 13.2, FRED SHEPARD at 10.6 and 7-0 LAURENT CRAWFORD, a transfer from Texas-El Paso who prepped at Chicago King, is at 10.6.

THE PANTHERS: JAY TAYLOR will be reinserted into the lineup at guard in place of TONY HEMPHILL, who has started all eight games previously but is only shooting 34% from the field although is averaging 10.9 ... TAYLOR, who has come off the bench in the three previous games, is the leading scorer at 14 even ...guard NORM EVANS has displayed the most consistency statistically as he's tops in FG% at 54.1%, second in scoring at 11.3, tied for third in rebounds at 4.3, tops with 18 assists and 11 steals .. .off to their poorest shooting start under Coach Rick Samuels, the Panthers are hitting just 42.5% from the field and have not been over 50% in any game with 49.1% vs. Northwest Missouri the best . . .concerned about rebounding at the start of the year, EIU does hold a statistical edge in that department, 38.3 to opponents 35.3. . . no one player is dominant as six are over four p/game with HEMPHILL high at 4.6.

COACH SAMUELS SEZ: "With these home games coming up we've put ourselves in position to get back to .500. The Southern win was a big one for our confidence as we displayed much better patience on offense although we still need to shoot much better. Our defense and rebounding was better at Southern, and those are two important items that have concerned us. We're also still searching for team consistency ... the right five guys who can best play together.
