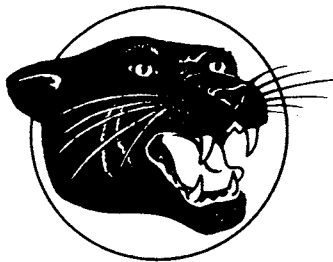

REVIEWING THE WEEK

MEN'S TRACK: Behind three conference record setting performances, the Panthers rolled to the Mid-Continent Conference Championship. EIU had 110, Northern Iowa 61, Western Illinois 45 and Southwest Missouri, allowed to compete although not a league member until next year, had 13. Perry Edinger (Mattoon) was the lone NCAA II qualifier winning the 3000 steeplechase in a 9:01.5 record time. Joe Sheeran (Grayslake-Lake Villa) won the 5000 run in a meet record 14:18.7 and then also won the 10,000 in 30:06.3. The 440 relay set a conference and varsity record in a 40.7 converted metric time. The four were Clayton Branch (Chicago-Westinghouse), Efrem Horton (Rockford-Auburn), Dwayne Brown (Chicago-Kenwood) and Claude Magee (Clermont, FL). The only other double winner was Magee who won the 100 (10.57) and 200 (21.74) dashes.

BASEBALL: The Panthers were idle this weekend but earned a bid to the NCAA II Great Lakes Regional with a 29-11 record. They will meet Lewis University (54-15) at 2 p.m. Thursday in Omaha, NB.

SOFTBALL: EIU ended its season by finishing 5th in the MAIAW II tournament with a 22-11 overall record. EIU lost to Indiana-Purdue of Indianapolis, 2-0, downed Akron, 6-0, but was eliminated by St. Francis, 4-3.
