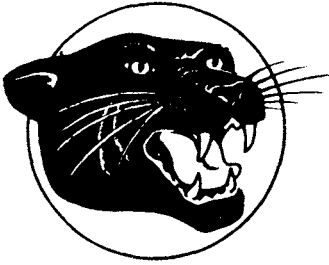

CHARLESTON, IL--Craig DeWall (Forreston), senior hurdler for Eastern Illinois University's track team, was the Panthers fourth leading scorer with 55 points.

DeWall had the team's top time in the 110 highs in 14.2 and second best in the 400 intermediates in 54.56. He placed third in the Mid-Continent championship with a 14.91 in the 110 highs.

He also ran the third leg of the team's fastest 4 x 100 relay (41.55) and 4 x 200 relay (1:27.7).

"Craig was a very consistent placer for us in both hurdles and relays and therefore really racked up some points. We'll miss his versatility," said coach Neil Moore.

"Initially we weren't figuring on using him in both relays but we had some injuries and he stepped in the 4 x 100 and had some consistent times."
