## REVIEWING THE WEEKEND (Jan. 30-31)

### MEN'S BASKETBALL

**LAST WEEK'S RESULTS:** The Panthers lost their fifth and sixth in a row losing to Cleveland State, 69-52, and Northern Iowa, 96-66, at home . . . it was the first time the Panthers had lost at home to UNI.

**RECORD:** EIU is now 5-11 overall, 0-5 in the AMCU-8 Conference and all alone in last place.

**UPCOMING GAMES:** EIU will play at St. Louis University on Thursday (Feb. 5) and then return home to host Western Illinois on Saturday (Feb. 7).

**AURORA (EAST) JAY TAYLOR,** sophomore guard, has returned to the starting lineup and leads the team with a 13.3 scoring average overall and 10.6 in the AMCU-8 . . . he had 11 vs. Cleveland State this past week but just six vs. Northern Iowa. . . he also leads the team with a 49.7% shooting percentage and is shooting 71.9% from the free throw line. . . he has been in double figures in 12 of the 15 games he played, missing one due to the flu.

**INDIANAPOLIS, IN-PARK TUDOR: TONY HEMPHILL,** junior forward, is second on the team with an 11.9 scoring average, and leads in conference games only with 11 ppg even. . . he has been in double figures in six of the last seven games but dropped to just four points vs. Northern Iowa . . . he had a team high 17 vs. Cleveland State. . . he leads the team with an 80% from the free throw line. . . although just shooting 40.4% overall that has improved recently as he's hitting 45.8% in the last five conference games . . . he also leads with 2.4 assists p/game.

JOLIET (CENTRAL): NORM EVANS, junior guard, is averaging in double figures at 10.2 but has been in a slight slump getting just 15 points in three games last week .. he has had 10 or more points in 10 games in this winter . . .he is shooting 48.8% from the field, 75.6% from the line and is averaging 4.6 rebounds p/game.

ROSELLE (LAKE PARK): DAVE VANCE, sophomore forward, has started all 16 games this year but has been a slump lately .. through the first eight games he was scoring over nine ppg but in the last eight has been under four ppg . . .in three games last week he scored just five points. ..he's averaging 6.6 overall, and 3.5 rebounds.

WARRENSBURG-LATHAM: MIKE WEST, sophomore center, continues to rank in the top ten in AMCU-8 rebounding with a 6.4 average . . .he had 10 vs. Cleveland State but only three vs. Northern Iowa on Saturday. . .he's averaging 5.1 pppg.

MOUNDS (MERIDIAN):JERRY STRICKLAND, junior forward, came off the bench to score 14 second half points vs. Northern Iowa . . . averaging about 13 minutes a game, Strickland is scoring 3.9 ppg and 2.5 rpg.

MONMOUTH: DAVID PAUL, sophomore guard, came off the bench vs. Northern Iowa to score 16 points . .12 of those came on 3-point shots as he hit a team high 4-5 from the field.

OSWEGO: BRIAN MURPHY, sophomore center, had his season high with 10 points vs. Northern Iowa . . .playing in a very limited role, he has appeared in just seven games and is scoring 2.6 ppg, 1.9 rpg.

#### MEN'S TRACK

WEEKEND RESULTS: The Panthers participated in the non scoring EIU Invitational on Friday against SIU-Edwardsville, Millikin, Rose-Hulman, Northeast Missouri and Parkland CC.

NEXT MEET: EIU will host Illinois Wesleyan, Millikin and Lewis University on Friday (Feb. 6) and then take a select few to the Illinois Invitational on Saturday (Feb. 7) at Champaign. Competition there will include Notre Dame, Wisconsin and Ohio State.

SHELBYVILLE: JIM MATON, junior middle distance runner, set an EIU and Lantz Fieldhouse record with a 1:10.88 in the 600 run . . . the old record was 1:11 set in 1977 by Reggie Johnson.

VIRDEN: MIKE HAMMAN, freshman high jumper, cleared 6-11 to set a freshman record and came within 3/4 inch of the school record . . .he was a prep finalist in the IHSA meet last spring.. the old frosh record was 6-8 1/2 by Bob Cervenka in 1978.

OAK PARK-RIVER FOREST: DAN MATAS, senior weightman, won the shot put in 54-6 1/2 and took second in the 35 lb. weight in 49-2 3/4.

QUINCY: ROBERT FLOT, sophomore hurdler, won the 60 HH in 7.78.

## WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

**LAST WEEK'S RESULTS:** The Lady Panthers remained in fourth place in the Gateway Conference standings with a 6-5 record. Eastern Illinois, 9-10 overall, got a school-record 35 points from senior guard Pat Hamilton in a 81-70 Gateway Conference win at Northern Iowa. The Lady Panthers lost 75-53 at Drake in their other league contest.

**UPCOMING GAMES:** EIU will host Illinois-Chicago at 7:30 p.m. Thursday (Feb. 5) in a non-conference game before traveling to Carbondale for a 7:35 start Saturday (Feb. 7) against league-leading Southern Illinois.

**COACH BARBARA HILKE SAYS:** "Pat's performance was great. The reason she had such a great game was because her defensive intensity was way up. It was a lot higher than it has been. She's so much quicker than the guards of Northern Iowa. UNI is such a tall team that Pat's speed took the wind out of their sails. Plus she got some great assists from Barb (Perkes) as usual. Barb played a perfect game, other than shooting, for a point guard. She had an amazing number of rebounds for a point guard."

**DECATUR (EISENHOWER):** Senior guard Pat Hamilton led EIU with a school-record 35 points and five steals against Northern Iowa. She also had five assists and four rebounds. Hamilton is third on the team in scoring with an average of 12.1 points per game and first with 2.4 steals per outing.

**ANTIOCH:** Sophomore center Brenda Webb had 16 points and four rebounds in 16 minutes against Northern Iowa. She is averaging 5.5 points per contest and has appeared in all 19 games this season.

**TRENTON (BREESE MATER DEI):** Freshman guard Barb Perkes had nine assists, seven rebounds and two points against Northern Iowa. She is tied for the team lead in scoring at 12.5 points per game and second in steals with 1.9 per contest.

**ANNA (JONESBORO):** Freshman center Laura Mull had 14 points on perfect six-of-six shooting against Northern Iowa. She is fourth in team scoring at 7.5 points per game, second in rebounding at 5.1 per outing and first in blocked shots with 17. She has started all 19 games this season.

**DES PLAINES (MARILLAC):** Junior forward Kerry Walsh scored 10 points on five-of-seven shooting and had four rebounds and four assists against Northern Iowa. She is averaging 2.8 points per game and 2.5 rebounds per game.

**EVANSTON:** Junior forward Ann Brown had a team-high nine rebounds against Northern Iowa. She also had four points and two steals. Brown is averaging 5.1 points and 5.0 rebounds per game.

## WOMEN'S TRACK AND FIELD

**WEEKEND RESULT:** EIU was fifth in its Lady Panther Invitational at Lantz Fieldhouse with 58 points. Purdue won the 11-team meet with 133.

**UPCOMING MEET:** EIU will host a triangular meet Saturday (Feb. 7) at 1 p.m. at Lantz Fieldhouse.

CHICAGO (SOUTH SHORE): Senior Valeta Strickland took top honors in the shot put with a toss of 44-6.

ELMHURST (YORK): Senior Lauren Lynch won the 880-yard run in 2:15.37 and anchored the two-mile relay team which set a school record of 9:04.26 en route to victory.

ST. CHARLES: Senior Janine Jarris ran the first leg of the winning and school-record setting two-mile relay team which finished in 9:04.26. She was fourth in the mile in 5:00.29.

BLUE ISLAND (EISENHOWER): Junior Tracy Olawumi ran the second leg of the winning and school-record setting two-mile relay team which finished in 9:04.26.

LITCHFIELD: Senior Kerri Sperry ran the third leg of the winning and school-record setting two-mile relay team which finished in 9:04.26.

CALUMET CITY (THORNWOOD SOUTH HOLLAND): Senior Debbie Zubik was runner-up in the shot put with a toss of 43-3.

HARVEY (THORNTON): Sophomore Lorry Plutz took second in the 440 at 59.09 and second in the 300 at 36.65.

#### WOMEN'S SWIMMING

WEEKEND RESULT: The Lady Panthers lost 120-83 to Western Illinois in a dual meet at Macomb.

UPCOMING MEETS: EIU will travel to Decatur to swim against Millkin in a dual meet Tuesday (Feb. 3) before competing Friday through Sunday (Feb. 6-8) in the Gateway Conference Championship at Carbondale.

CHICAGO (MOTHER MACAULEY): Sophomore Carolyn Guditis took top honors in the 200-yard freestyle in 2:05.95.

COLLINSVILLE: Freshman Lisa Rauk won the one-meter diving competition with 141.9 points.

#### WRESTLING

WEEKEND RESULT: EIU placed fifth in the Hoosier Invitational at Bloomington, IN. West Virginia won the eight-team meet.

NEXT MEET: The Panthers will host Illinois State in a dual meet on Friday (Feb. 6).

COACH RALPH MCCAUSLAND SAYS: "This was a really good tournament. There was some tough competition, and it really helped our guys out. We started slowly, but we came back with some big wins. This tournament showed us that in a meet of this caliber we have to be prepared for every match."

CHICAGO HEIGHTS (RICH CENTRAL/LINCOLN CC): Senior Demetrius Harper captured second place in the heavyweight division, going 2-1 in the meet. He lost 1-0 in overtime in the championship bout.

JOLIET (WEST): Sophomore Craig Sterr placed third in the 118-pound division to improve his season mark to 20-6.
