CHARLESTON -- Eastern Illinois University will ring-in the holiday season by hosting a party for all area citizens and the university community from 5 to 7 p.m. Tuesday, Dec. 12 in the foyer of Old Main.

Refreshments and entertainment will be provided, and guests can come-and-go as they wish.

In preparation for the EIU/Community Holiday Party, a 20-foot white pine, lighted tree has been placed in the lobby of Old Main and can be seen at night by motorists driving by. The outside of Old Main has also been lined in lights.
