

CHARLESTON, IL--Eastern Illinois University's field hockey team opens its home season hosting Principia College and Southern Illinois-Carbondale Saturday (Sept. 18). The EIU-Principia contest begins at 9 a.m. with the Panthers facing the Salukis at 12:30. SIU-C and Principia meet at 3:30 p.m. on the Panthers' field hockey field.

The Panthers, 1-1, were dealt a setback as Ann Bohannon (Pana) a starter at left link the past three years has mononucleosis, according to head coach Beth Reichel.

"We will very much miss Annie," Reichel said. "She has been told by her doctor not to compete for at least two weeks and to get plenty of rest.

"She played last weekend and being the tough competitor she is did not take herself out of the Ball State game until the middle of the second half.

"Colleen (Fletcher-Mascoutah) should be at practice and ready for Saturday. She still has a slight headache after accidentally being hit on the head in the Valparaiso game.

"Nancy Fanta (Western Springs-LaGrange Lyons) will move back to take Ann's spot and Cheryl (Holthaus-Pana) will get a start at one of the wings," Reichel said.

"Southern is very tough. They return 10 starters including their second-leading all-time scorer (Ellen Massey) and an All-American Honorable Mention midfielder (Barb Smith)."

Following the triangular with Principia and SIU-C the Panthers travel to Indiana State Tuesday (Sept. 21) as Eastern will play its first ever night game. Game time is 6:30 p.m.
