WOOTTON JOINS EASTERN

CHARLESTON, IL--Charles Wootton, son of Mrs. Geneva Wootton of Elizabethtown, has joined the faculty of Eastern Illinois University in Charleston as an associate professor of Accountancy, Data Processing and Finance.

Eastern Illinois University places priority on teaching excellence for a high quality student body in a residential setting. Approximately 10,000 on-campus students are enrolled in undergraduate and graduate programs. Non-traditional and part-time students are enrolled in programs at both on- and off-campus sites. Eastern offers faculty a wide range of research

and public service activities. The University is located in east central Illinois and combines the benefits of a community of 20,000 with access to several large cities, including Chicago, St. Louis and Indianapolis.

Before coming to Eastern, Wootton was an instructor at St. Johns River Junior College for five years. He also spent three years as a graduate assistant at Mississippi State University. After that, he was an assistant professor at Mississippi University for Women for seven years. Most recently, he spent six years as an assistant professor at Southwest Missouri State University.

Wootton received a doctorate in 1982 and a master's degree in 1973 from Mississippi State University. He received another master's degree in 1967 and a bachelor's degree in 1966 from Murray State University. He is a 1963 graduate of Rosiclare High School.
