CHARLESTON, IL --Two watercolors by Don Carmichael, Director of the Tarble Arts Center at Eastern Illinois University are included in a new volume titled "Creative Landscape Painting."

The author, Edward Betts, describes Carmichael as "an inveterate explorer in the field of aquamedia techniques. Although he lives in the Midwest, his imagery is predominantly related to coastal waters..."

Carmichael's works are "Lonely Vigil," reproduced in black and white, and "Wave Motion II," printed in full color.

Carmichael's paintings have been exhibited across the United States and in France, England and Italy. He is a former head of the Department of Art, Union University, and is co-founder and past president of the Tennessee Watercolor Society. Carmichael came to Eastern in 1978.
