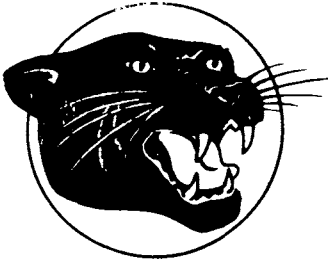

CHARLESTON, IL--Following a weekend off, Eastern Illinois University's field hockey team will play two games this weekend (Oct. 1-2) in St. Louis.

The Panthers, 2-3, will play St. Louis University Friday and Western Illinois on Saturday. They also will meet the St. Louis club team in an exhibition game.

Deb Seybert (Edwardsville) continues to lead the Panthers in scoring with 14 points on 10 goals and four assists. Gail Niebur (Edwardsville) is next with 11 points on six goals and five assists.

Goalie Judy Waterbury (Hoffman Estates-Conant) has a 1.40 goals against average.

"We are looking forward to this weekend," coach Beth Reichel said. "Coming off a week off we got the kinks out yesterday (Monday) at practice tuning up for St. Louis. They (St. Louis) lost to Carbondale (3-1) and we had a tough 1-0 loss to SIU consequently it should be an even game.

"We will have no changes in our lineup . . . Annie (Ann Bohannon-Pana who has been out with mononucleosis since Sept. 13) will be back in our lineup," Reichel added.
