GREATHOUSE JOINS EASTERN

CHARLESTON, IL--Noëlle Greathouse, daughter of Mrs. Marion Rich of Hindsboro, has joined the faculty of Eastern Illinois University in Charleston as an Assistant Professor in Student Teaching.

Eastern Illinois University places priority on teaching excellence for a high quality student body in a residential setting. Approximately 10,000 on-campus students are enrolled in undergraduate and graduate programs. Non-traditional and part-time students are enrolled in programs at both on- and off-campus sites.
