CHARLESTON, IL.--Jill Arseneau of Beaverville (Donovan), Eastern Illinois University junior business education major, is one of six recipients of the prestigious Livingston C. Lord Memorial Scholarship.

Established by the alumni association in memory of Lord, president of EIU from 1899-1933, this is the University's highest award for scholarship.

The six students, who represent the University's six academic colleges, received their awards at commencement.
