REUTTER JOINS EASTERN

CHARLESTON, IL--Elizabeth Reutter, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Willie Doublin of St. Charles, Mo., has joined the faculty of Eastern Illinois University in Charleston as a Home Economics instructor.

Eastern Illinois University places priority on teaching excellence for a high quality student body in a residential setting. Approximately 10,000 on-campus students are enrolled in undergraduate and graduate programs. Non-traditional and part-time students are enrolled in programs at both on- and off-campus sites. Eastern offers faculty a wide range of research and public service activities. The University is located in east central Illinois and combines the benefits of a community of 20,000 with access to several large cities, including Chicago, St. Louis and Indianapolis.

Before coming to Eastern, Reutter was an instructor for two years at Parkland College in Champaign, Ill. Prior to that she taught for six years at Mt. Vernon Township High School.
