

## EIU FIELD HOCKEY ITEMS

Sept. 21, 1981

NEXT ACTION: The Eastern Illinois University women's field hockey team hosts Indiana State tomorrow (Tuesday) at 3:30 p.m. on the field located near Lantz Gym. The Panthers compete in the Indiana Invitational at Bloomington, Ind., this weekend. EIU is 5-2 for the season.

EIU WINS 2 AT CARBONDALE -- EIU women's field hockey team won two games at Southern Illinois University at Carbondale, Ill., last Saturday. The Panthers defeated Principia College 3-1 and the host, SIU-Carbondale 2-1. The 2-1 win over SIU-Carbondale is the first victory for a Panther field hockey team over the Salukis since prior to the 1976 season. According to Julee Illner, field hockey coach at SIU-Carbondale, EIU has not defeated a SIU-Carbondale team since either the 1974 or '75 season.

EIU VS. PRINCIPIA -- The Panthers defeated Principia College 3-1 last Saturday at Carbondale, Ill., on goals by Peggy Moore (senior of Mt. Zion/Mt. Zion) her second of the season and Deb Seybert (junior of Edwardsville/Edwardsville) tallied her ninth and 10th goals of the year. Judy Waterbury (sophomore of Hoffman Estates/James B. Conant) had just two saves in goal as the EIU Panthers outshot Principia 28-4. Nancy Hack made 25 saves off Panther sticks for Principia in goal.

PANTHERS AT SIU-CARBONDALE -- The EIU Panthers nipped Southern Illinois University at Carbondale, Ill., last Saturday afternoon 2-1. Gail Neibur (freshman of Edwardsville/Edwardsville) scored at 11:20 of the first half on a pass from Seybert (Deb). SIU-Carbondale's goal came on a penalty stroke at the 30 minute mark. Seybert scored the game-winner at 22:00 of the second 35 minute half as MacIntosh (Gigi, senior co-captain of Macon/Mt. Zion) fired over a perfect pass right in front and Deb had her 11th goal of the season. Waterbury (Judy) had nine saves as EIU outshot SIU-Carbondale 13-9.

COACH REICHEL COMMENTS -- EIU head coach Beth Reichel had these comments following the victory over SIU-Carbondale, "we were just ecstatic after Deb (Seybert) scored to give us a 2-1 lead. The team played so well that everything clicked. I can't single out any one player; it was a team effort and we are very happy." The playing conditions were great; not like last Thurs."

SEYBERT LEADS EIU IN SCORING -- Deb Seybert picked up three goals last Saturday at Carbondale, Ill., to boost her team-leading total to 11.

WATERBURY 5-1 IN EIU NETS -- Judy Waterbury returned in goal for the EIU Panthers last Saturday at Carbondale, Ill., and earned two victories to raise her season record to 5-1. Her goals against average (GAA) stands at 1.00 (six goals in six games). Judy has played 380 minutes and has 37 saves in the Panthers' nets.

EIU SUFFERS 4-1 DEFEAT TO WIU -- Western Illinois University defeated EIU 4-1 in a driving thunderstorm, last Thursday in the Panthers' home opener. Seybert (Deb) scored the lone goal for EIU on a penalty stroke at 27 minutes of the first half which made the score 2-1 WIU at the half. Deb King (junior of Sidney, Ohio) started her first game in goal for the Panthers and made 16 saves. She was injured in the game and her status for this week is unknown.
