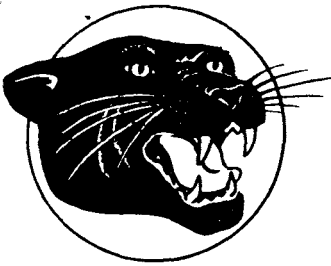

EIU WOMEN'S FIELD HOCKEY ITEMS

NEXT ACTION: The Eastern Illinois University women's field hockey team hosts Purdue University Wednesday on the field located near Lantz Gym. Bully is at 4 p.m. EIU travels to Dayton, Ohio Saturday to meet the University of Dayton Flyers at 2:30 p.m. EIU is 8-4 for the season.

PANTHERS SPLIT FOUR AT INDIANA -- EIU split four games last weekend at the University of Indiana in Bloomington, Ind. The Panthers defeated Michigan State and the host U of Indiana by identical 2-1 counts last Friday to run its unbeaten string to five games (four straight over Division I teams). EIU was defeated by Division I opponents Ohio State, 4-1 and Central Michigan 2-1 last Saturday afternoon.

EIU VS. MICHIGAN STATE -- The Panthers' Peggy Moore (senior co-captain of Mt. Zion/Mt. Zion) scored at the four-minute mark of the first half against Michigan State in their first game of the U of Indiana Invitational at Bloomington, Ind., last Friday. The goal was Moore's fourth (4th) of the season. Colleen Fletcher (junior of Mascoutah/Mascoutah Community) scored what proved to be the game-winner with just seven minutes left in the game; it could not have come at a better time for Colleen to earn her first goal of the season. Deb King (junior of Sidney, Ohio/Sidney) stopped nine Spartans shots in the Panther net. Both teams had 10 shots on goal.

EIU AT U OF INDIANA -- EIU nipped the University of Indiana 2-1 last Friday in their second game of the University of Indiana Invitational at Bloomington, Ind. Gail Neibur (freshman of Edwardsville/Edwardsville) scored both Panther goals, her fourth and fifth of the season. The game was scoreless at halftime. Gail scored her first of the game at 5:01 of the second 35-minute stanza with Deb Seybert (junior of Edwardsville/Edwardsville) getting the assist. Neibur's second goal proved to be the game-winner at the 14-minute mark. King again was in goal for EIU and stopped 11 Hoosier shots. Indiana outshot EIU 12-11.

EIU VS. OHIO STATE -- The Panther's saw their five-game winning streak come to an end when Ohio State defeated EIU 4-1 last Saturday in the University of Indiana Invitational at Bloomington, Ind. Sue Carr (senior of DeKalb/DeKalb Senior) scored the lone Panther goal at the 17-minute mark of the first half. King made eight saves against the Buckeyes. EIU outshot Ohio State 13-12.

EIU VS. CENTRAL MICHIGAN -- EIU did everything against Central Michigan except win the game last Saturday afternoon in the final contest of the University of Indiana Invitational at Bloomington, Ind. Central Michigan nipped the Panthers 2-1. Carr (Sue) scored her second goal of the season at the 24-minute mark of the first half for the lone EIU goal. EIU outshot CM 20-3 and had 21 penalty corners compared to just four for CM. King (Deb) made one save against the Chippewas. The Central Michigan goalie Lynn Ridinger stopped 19 Panthers' shots in the game.

COACH REICHEL COMMENTS -- EIU first-year coach Beth Reichel said, "we were happy with the way we played last weekend. EIU was the lone Division II team there and definitely were the underdog."

ON UPCOMING EIU GAMES -- "Purdue will be good competition for us as they tied Penn State (National AIAW Division I Champions last year) 1-1 their second game of the season. Dayton should also be a good game."

LAST MEETINGS -- EIU was nipped by the Purdue Boilermakers 1-0 last October 7 at West Lafayette, Ind. Dayton and EIU faced each other twice last season: the flyers nipped the Panthers 2-1 Oct. 18 here in Charleston, however EIU won the MAIAW Region title with a 2-1 victory Nov. 8 at Brooklyn, Mich.
