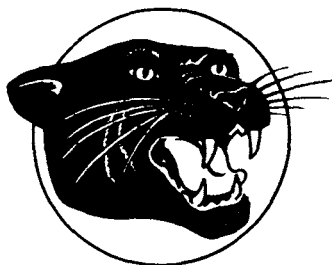

REVIEWING THE WEEKEND (Sept. 25-26)

FOOTBALL: The Panthers overwhelmed Central State University 58-0 behind the passing of Jeff Christensen (Gibson City) and the receiving of Roger Holoman (Alton). Christensen completed 20 of 30 passes for 274 yards and four TD passes. Holoman caught 11 for 193 yards, the second best receiving day in EIU history, and three TDs. The defense yielded just 65 total yards.

MEN'S CROSS COUNTRY: The Panthers were fifth out of 27 teams at the TFA/USA meet. Saginaw Valley had 43, Missouri 56; Northwest Missouri 119, Southwest Michigan JC 135 and the Panthers 151
