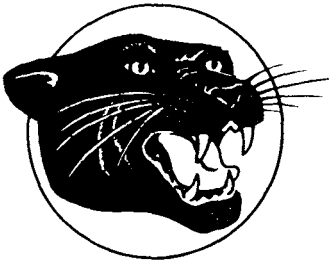

## EIU WOMEN'S TENNIS ITEMS

EIU AT 66TH MILLIKIN TOURNEY -- The Eastern Illinois University women's tennis team will be represented in the 66th Annual Millikin Invitational at Decatur, Ill., this weekend. Play begins at 9 a.m. Friday and concludes Saturday. No team scores are recorded.

PANTHERS WIN TWO AT WIU -- The Panthers won two matches at the Western Illinois University in Macomb, Ill., last weekend to run its record to 4-2. EIU nipped the WIU Westerwinds 5-4 last Friday and swept the University of Illinois-Chicago Circle 9-0 last Saturday.

EIU CURRENT INDIVIDUAL RECORDS -- Raeann Huhn, senior of Peru (LaSalle-Peru) has the best singles record for the Panthers after six matches. Huhn won both of her number six matches last weekend to raise her record to 5-1. Jill Anderson, senior of Park Forest (Eastridge), Janet Haberkorn, senior of Arlington Heights (Arlington Heights), Julie Krueger, senior of Neoga (Neoga) and Kristen Peterson, junior of Fairfield (Fairfield) all have 3-3 records competing at number one, three, five and four singles respectively. Josie Riberto, senior of Kankakee (East Ridge) won both of her number two singles' matches last weekend and is 2-4 for the season.

EIU DOUBLES RECORDS -- Anderson (Jill) and Riberto (Josie) have teamed for a 4-2 record at number one doubles. Janet (Haberkorn) and Kristen (Peterson) are 2-4 at number two doubles and Huhn (Raeann) and Krueger (Julie) have the best EIU doubles record of 4-1 playing third. Dawn Pavlik, freshman of Geneva (St. Edward Cathedral) and Nancy Abney, freshman of Kankakee (Eastridge) got their first opportunity to compete in the starting lineup last Saturday and defeated Wendy Zyarnecki and Diane Leninger of the University of Chicago-Circle at number three doubles, 6-1, 6-2.

COACH EARLEY COMMENTS -- EIU coach Karen Earley said, "we were pleased with our performances last weekend. Josie (Riberto) had two very good wins; especially her three-setter over Sue Legatowicz (Western Illinois U, 1-6, 6-1 and 6-2). The Millikin Tournament is one of the most prestigious events in women's tennis. Jill (Anderson) finished third last year. It's a fun tournament and we are honored to be competing there."

SIU-EDWARDSVILLE INVITE NEXT -- Following the Millikin Tournament this weekend the EIU women's tennis team will compete in the Southern Illinois University at Edwardsville Invitational Oct. 9-10.
