HUNTER JOINS EASTERN

CHARLESTON, IL--Dave Hunter, son of Mr. and Mrs. David Hunter of Champaign, has joined the faculty at Eastern Illinois University as a Psychology instructor.

Eastern Illinois University places priority on teaching excellence for a high quality student body in a residential setting.
