PENCEK JOINS EASTERN

CHARLESTON, IL--Thomas Pencek, son of Matilda Pencek of Dunkirk, New York, has joined the faculty at Eastern Illinois University as an assistant professor of Finance.

Eastern Illinois University places priority on teaching excellence for a high quality student body in a residential setting. Approximately 10,000 on-campus students are enrolled in undergraduate and graduate programs. Non-traditional and part-time students are enrolled in programs at both on- and off-campus sites. Eastern offers faculty a wide range of research and public service activities. Before coming to Eastern, Pencek was an assistant professor at Rhode Island College for four years.
