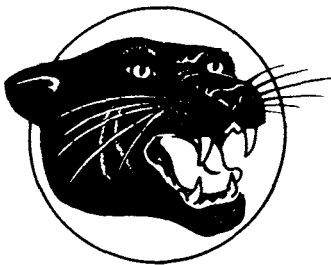

PANTHERS AT DOROTHY McCLURE INVITE -- The EIU women Panthers were represented in the 66th Annual Dorothy McClure Invitational at Millikin University in Decatur, IL last weekend.

KRUEGER & HUHNS REACH QUARTERFINALS -- Julie Krueger, senior of Neoga (Neoga) and Raeann Huhn, senior of Peru (LaSalle-Peru) reached the quarterfinals of the number two doubles of the Dorothy McClure Invitational at Decatur, IL last Friday. They defeated Faux and Maloney of Western Illinois University 6-2, 4-6 and 6-2; defeated Wronski and Juinenez of Augustana (IL) 7-5, 6-7 and 6-4 before losing to Nancy Webber and Susie Uranich of Illinois State 6-1 and 6-2. Krueger and Huhn are now 6-2 for the season in doubles' action.
