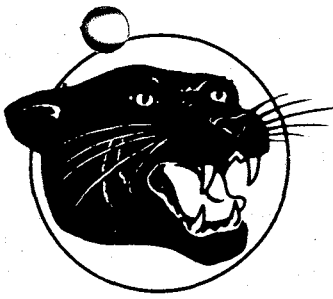

CHARLESTON, IL--Two California junior college transfers, Evan Arapostathis (LaMesa, CA-Heliz/Grossmount CC) and Steve Berryman (San Bernardino, CA-Coltan/San Bernardino Valley CC), were the kicking specialists for Eastern Illinois University's football Panthers this fall.

EIU finished 6-5, its seventh straight winning season, and shared the Mid-Continent Conference title, the fifth straight year it has either won or been co-champs of the MCC.

Berryman was the team's second leading scorer with 63 points, and earned second-team All-MCC honors. He connected on 33-36 PATs and 10-16 field goals. His longest field goal was a 50 yarder, his only attempt at that distance. He was 6-9 from 30-39 yards, 2-3 of 20-29 yards and 1-3 from 40-49 yards.

Arapostathis punted 58 times for a 34.0 average with a 50 yarder his longest. Earlier in the year he was the placekicker getting 2-2 PATs and 1-2 field goals for five points.
