REVIEWING THE WEEKEND (Nov. 23-24)

**MEN'S BASKETBALL:** The Panthers lost an exhibition game ten days ago to an Iowa AAU team, 101-100, as Jon Collins (East St. Louis-Cahokia) scored 23 points . . . EIU has not played since but did open the season Monday (Nov. 26) at Eastern Washington.

**WOMEN'S BASKETBALL:** The Eastern Illinois women's basketball team (1-1) captured runner-up honors at the Central Florida Sunroast Invitational this past weekend at Orlando, Fla. The Lady Panthers nipped Florida International--77-73--in overtime Friday night. Junior forward Chris Aldridge (Taylorville) hit an eight foot shot with two seconds left in regulation to send the game into an extra session. Aldridge led the team in scoring with 20 points while junior guard Melanie Hatfield (Lawrenceburg, Ind.) hauled in a game-high 11 rebounds. EIU was overwhelmed by host Central Florida Saturday night and lost to the Lady Knights by a 75-49 count. Central Florida led by seven points at intermission before it opened up the second half with a 19-4 spurt and engineered a commanding 53-30 lead with 11 minutes to go in the contest. Senior forward Toni Collins led the Lady Panthers with 13 points and 16 rebounds. Aldridge and Collins were named to the all-tournament team.

CHRIS ALDRIDGE (Taylorville), junior forward, leads the team with a 15 points per game average. She had 20 points in the overtime win against Florida International and scored four points in overtime. Aldridge was selected to the all-tournament squad.

TONI COLLINS (Lincoln/Jamaica-Sidell), senior forward, is second on the team with a 13.5 points per game average. She paces the team in rebounds with 12.5 a game. Collins was named to the all-tournament team.

KIM MAXEY (Mattoon), junior guard, is averaging 9.5 points a contest while shooting from the 18-22 foot range. She hit a 20-footer from the right side to tie the Florida International game at 63-all with 45 seconds left.

SUE HYND (Ottawa), junior center, scored 12 points in the overtime win against Florida International. She hit 10 of her 12 points down the stretch in clutch situations.
