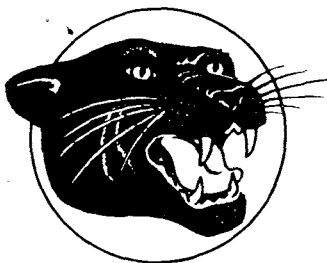

## EIU FIELD HOCKEY ITEMS

NEXT ACTION: The Eastern Illinois University women's field hockey team will compete in the Lake Forest College Invitational at Lake Forest, IL this weekend. Action begins Saturday at 9 a.m. as EIU meets the University of Chicago. Other teams include DePauw, Concordia (Ill.), Southern Illinois University-Edwardsville and Lake Forest College. EIU is 12-5 for the season.

PANTHERS SPLIT TWO GAMES AT SIU-EDWARDSVILLE -- On a rain-soaked field in Edwardsville, IL, last Saturday the EIU Panthers nipped the Cougars of SIU-Edwardsville 5-4 in double overtime and penalty flicks. Central Missouri State tripped EIU 3-2 in double overtime also last Saturday in Edwardsville, IL, Rain delayed the start of the EIU-CMS game two hours.

EIU AT SIU-EDWARDSVILLE -- Deb Seybert, junior of Edwardsville (Edwardsville), returned home last Saturday and had an excellent day. She started off the scoring at the eight-minute mark of the first half to give the Panthers a 1-0 lead. Sue Carr, senior of DeKalb (DeKalb Senior) assisted on Deb's 15th goal of the season. Edwardsville scored twice before intermission and led 2-1 after the first 35 minutes. Peggy Moore, senior co-captain of Mt. Zion (Mt. Zion) took a pass from Seybert with 16 minutes remaining in regulation to knot the score at 2-2. It was Moore's seventh goal of the year. EIU got Penalty Flicks from Mary Ohl, junior of Mascoutah (Mascoutah Community) (her first goal of the season), Kathy Sherer, junior of Rockford (Rockford West) (her second goal of the season) and Gail Nieber, freshman of Edwardsville (Edwardsville) earned the game-winner on the final flick for her ninth goal of the season. Deb King, junior goalie of Sidney, Ohio, suffered a concussion during the Penalty Flicks and was taken to a nearby hospital; her condition was good Sunday afternoon. King had another outstanding game as she stopped 11 shots. EIU outshot SIU-Edwardsville 25-11.

PANTHERS VS. JENNIES -- Central Missouri State's Jennies and Eastern Illinois University's Panthers had not met since the opening game of the AIAW Division II Nationals Nov. 19, 1980 in Edwardsville. EIU won that game 3-1 before being defeated by LaSalle in semi-final action. (NOTE: LaSalle won the AIAW Division II Nationals defeating Southwest Missouri State 3-2) Central Missouri State faced Judy Waterbury, sophomore of Hoffman Estates (James B. Conant) in goal for the Panthers. Waterbury was playing due to Deb King's injury in the SIU-Edwardsville game that morning. Judy made 22 saves and played very well as she was suffering with a temperature of 101°<sup>OF</sup>. CMS outshot EIU 25-22. Seybert (Deb) scored her 16th goal of the season on a Penalty Stroke at the eight-minute mark of the first half. Niebur (Gail) scored her 10th of the year at the four-minute mark of the second half with the assist going to Moore (Peggy), Renie Rice scored the game-winner for CMS with two minutes remaining in the second overtime.

COACH REICHEL'S COMMENTS -- EIU first-year coach Beth Reichel had these comments following the trip to Edwardsville, IL last weekend: "We won the game we had to; SIU-Edwardsville will be at Lake Forest and we will play them there and again the 28th here at home in the second game of state. Playing conditions were poor. It rained during the second half of the Edwardsville game and we had to postpone the start of our game with Central Missouri State two hours."

ON OVERALL PLAY AT SIU-EDWARDSVILLE -- "We are glad to see our scoring is becoming more balanced . . . we seemed to rely on Deb (Seybert) early in the year. Mo's (Mary Ohl) Penalty Flick was a good one for her as she has been working hard to perfect them all year."
