Minutes of March 30, 1976

The meeting was called to order at 1405.

REPORTS

1. Elections Committee---Price

Price reported the results of the faculty elections (see Appendix A).

It was moved (Buchanan) and seconded (Dolton) that the Senate ratify the election results.

Motion carried unanimously.

The run-off election will be held between 800 and 1700 on April 8, 1976. Absentee ballots may be cast in Science 328 by faculty unable to be present on April 8.

Secretary Goodrich reported that the cost of printing the candidates answers to the questions asked by the Senate committees, (published as Appendix B of the minutes of March 9, 1976), amounted to \$112.04.

2. Student-Faculty Relations Committee---Rearden

Rearden reported that discussions between the Committee and the student leadership on the grade appeals system were continuing.

3. Budget Committee---Hackler

It was reported that progress on the 1976-77 budget was being made by the Budget Committee, but that firm figures cannot be predicted at this time.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Regional Bicentennial Exhibition.

The Senate has received a request from J. Linn, Art Department, that the Senate support an appeal for faculty support for a purchase award at the Exhibition.

It was moved (Buchanan) and seconded (Price) that the Senate publish the letter from Dr. Linn (see Appendix B), and encourage each faculty member to make a contribution to help underwrite the purchase award.

Motion carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Collective bargaining forum.

The Senate discussed at some length the nature of the presentation to be made by Chairman Weidner at the forum to be held April 8. After further study of the BOG regulations during the week, this matter will be given further consideration at the Senate meeting of April 6.

2. Student-Faculty Boards---Buchanan

Buchanan reported that the Nominations Committee will need nominations (or volunteers) for the Student-Faculty Boards to be appointed for 1976-77. A call for volunteers with a list of current membership is found in Appendix C.

Meeting adjourned at 1510.

Next Faculty Senate meeting is scheduled for April 6, 1976 at 1400 in the Faculty Union Martinsville Room.

## Appendix B

The Art Department and the Paul Sargent Gallery of Eastern Illinois University are hosting a juried Regional Bicentennial Exhibition this coming September. The exhibition will attract entries from hundreds of the very best professional artists from the surrounding seven state region. The exhibition will be juried by a nationally renowned art critic. As of this writing Robert Hughes of TIME magazine is to jury the show.

The juror will select prize winning works from among the paintings, sculpture, drawings, prints, ceramics, and other works submitted to the exhibition. Thus far, solicitations from the community have amounted to approximately \$3,500. in cash for the Purchase Award program. The response from the Charleston-Mattoon area has been overwhelming. It is hoped that the University Community will respond in a similarly gratifying manner.

A Purchase Award is a cash prize conferred upon the artist for his winning entry which is then turned over to the organization or patron sponsoring the award. Hence, in effect, the patron is purchasing a prize winning work.

The Art Department and Paul Sargent Gallery would like to give the Faculty and Staff of Eastern Illinois University an opportunity to participate in the Purchase Award program. It is hoped that an "E.I.U. Faculty and Staff Purchase Award" can be instituted for the exhibition. Contributions of \$10.00 per individual are being sought. Contributions are tax deductible. It is hoped that the Faculty and Staff can underwrite the \$2,000. Best-in-Show Award. The award winning work can then be installed permanently in some suitable location, e.g. Old Main, the New Union Ballroom Foyer, etc. Below is a tear off sheet to send along with each contribution in the form of a check made out to E.I.U.
