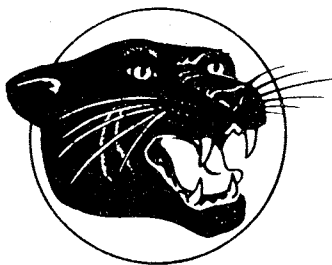

## REVIEWING THE WEEKEND: (Oct. 16-17)

**FOOTBALL:** The Panthers bounced back with a 20-8 win over Western Illinois as Tyrone Davis (East St. Louis-Lincoln) ran for a personal high 106 yards and three TDs. Davis carried the ball 30 times Saturday. Previously he had only 24 rushing attempts in five games. The win boosted EIU to 4-2 overall and 2-0 in the Mid-Continent Conference. A victory over Northern Iowa on October 31 would give the Panthers their second straight undisputed conference championship.

**SOCCER:** Eastern posted a record 11th shutout blanking Roosevelt, 8-0, as Damien Kelly scored three goals and Agyeman Prempeh added two. The Panthers, ranked 5th by the Inter-collegiate Soccer Athletic Association, are 11-1-1. Kelly now has 16 goals, just four shy of tying the single season record.

**MEN'S CROSS COUNTRY:** Perry Edinger's (Mattoon) 18th place paced Eastern to 5th place out of 15 teams at the Illinois Intercollegiate. Edinger covered the five mile course in 24:28.
