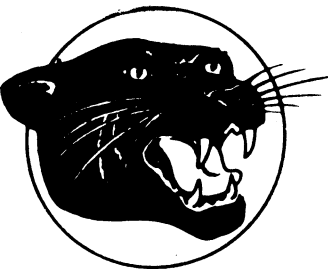

CHARLESTON, IL--Five junior college transfers, three from Illinois and two from California, have signed football scholarships to attend Eastern Illinois University, head coach Al Molde announced.

The three Illinoisans are Willie Cain, a 6-1, 180 wide receiver who is from Chicago Harper HS and first enrolled at Eastern in 1982 but played at the College of Eastern Utah the past two years; Charles Williams, a 6-1, 180 wide receiver who prepped in Los Angeles but played at Triton (IL) JC; and Dan Polewski (pronounced puh-lew-ski), a 6-2, 235 inside linebacker from Thornton JC who prepped at Thornridge HS.

The Californians are Allan Ziemann, a 6-1, 200 outside linebacker from San Diego Mesa CC and Gregory Rhea (pronounced Ray), a 5-8, 170 cornerback from Cerritos (CA) CC.

"Speed is the one physical characteristic all five have in common," said Molde, "particularly Cain, Williams and Rhea who are in the 4.5 range for the 40 . . . getting people with speed is a high priority and we're on the right track with these first recruits."

All five will enroll in January for spring semester therefore "they will benefit from being involved in our winter conditioning and spring drills," Molde said.
