CHARLESTON, IL--Allison Anne Hill, daughter of Michael and Nancy Hill of St. Charles, was among more than 1,200 students awarded degrees from Eastern Illinois University at the spring 1993 commencement ceremony.

A 1989 graduate of St. Charles High School, Hill was a psychology major in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences at Eastern. While a student at Eastern, she was on the Dean's List several times and was a member of Psi Chi, the National Honor Society in Psychology.
