EIU SPRING COURSES OFFERED AT PARKLAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE

CHARLESTON, IL--Eastern Illinois University will offer 21 spring semester courses at Parkland Community College, ranging from art to psychology.

Courses, beginning Jan. 13, will be held evenings and weekends, and provide credit toward bachelor's and master's degrees, including a Bachelor of Science in Career Occupations, Board of Governors Bachelor of Arts and Master of Science in Technology.

Among the courses will be ART 3997, "Theories and Fundamentals of Art"; COS 4810, "Principles of Career Development"; EDF 2171, "Schools, Citizens and Society"; HIS 3740, "World War II"; HST 4800, "Drugs and Society"; and Psy 4997, "Psychology of Dreaming."

These programs provide an opportunity for working adults in the Champaign-Urbana area to earn a degree at their own pace with classes conveniently scheduled for evenings and weekends.

To receive a schedule or to register, individuals should contact the area Eastern Illinois University School of Adult and Continuing Education representative at Chanute Air Force Base in Rantoul. Office hours are 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Monday through Friday, or phone, 893-4144.
