## REVIEWING THE WEEKEND (November 27-28)

**MEN'S BASKETBALL:** The Panthers lost the opener, 96-88 in overtime, to Kent State. EIU was outrebounded 38-29 as KSU's Ed Kaminski had a career high 25 points, 19 rebounds.

WARREN PATTEN (Memphis, TN-Westark, AR CC) had a career high 24 points hitting 11 of 16 from the field. He also led with seven rebounds and five assists.

RICKY ROBINSON (Aurora-East) had 19 points on eight of 13 from the field however missed most of the second half due to a bruised ankle. He is not expected to miss any games.

EDDIE JONES (Chicago-Cregier/Lincoln CC) scored 13 points but only connected on four of 18 field goal attempts.

LEIGH HANKINS (South Beloit) scored a career high 12 points and led with seven assists. He hit five of seven from the field and had five rebounds.

**WRESTLING:** Geno Savegnago (Carol Stream-Glenbard North) finished 2nd at 190 lbs. in the Southern Open at Chattanooga. He was 4-1 losing the title to Noel Logan, a former national champ.

Derek Porter (Mims, FL-Titusville) was 4th at 126 losing the 3rd place bout to last year's national runnerup. Porter had a 4-2 record.

**MEN'S SWIMMING:** The Panthers were idle this past weekend but open the home season by hosting Illinois State in a coed meet at 2 p.m. Friday (Dec. 4). Then Saturday they will compete in the Illinois State Relays at Normal.
