KIMBLE SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

As the freshman recipient of the Cooley-Marathon Scholarship, Kimble is eligible to receive a \$500 scholarship renewable each of her four years at Eastern as long as she continues to be enrolled in the business field and maintains satisfactory academic standing.

The Cooley-Marathon Scholarship fund was established as a joint venture by Rex D. and Nancy A. Cooley of Findlay, Ohio, in cooperation with the Marathon Oil Foundation to provide financial assistance to students who declare pre-business as a major.

Cooley, a '59 EIU accounting graduate, is Senior Vice-President for Finance and Administration and Board of Directors member at Marathon Oil Company.

The scholarship program is designed so that eventually four business students will be receiving the award simultaneously.
