CHARLESTON, IL.--Frantz Dantzler, North Central Regional Director for the United States Humane Society, will lecture on the care of animals at 7 p.m., Thursday, June 26 in Eastern Illinois University's Buzzard Auditorium.

Dantzler's lecture is sponsored by the Coles County Animal Shelter as part of the Tarble Arts Center month long photographic exhibition on 'The Dog Observed'.

His slide presentation/lecture, which is open to the public, will focus on educating the public about caring for domestic pets.

Dantzler has appeared frequently on all major network and cable news programs. His North Central Region office is located in Lansing (IL) and includes the states of Illinois, Wisconsin, Minnesota, North and South Dakota.

Prior to this position, Dantzler was Director of Investigations for the humane society. He has traveled extensively in North America investigating animal cruelty issues.
