- II. Communications:

- III. Dr. Baumgardner announced the appointment of Dr. J. Ivarie and Dr. McGown to the Committee on Reinstatement.
- IV. Executive Officers Report - The following two items were accepted unanimously by the Council:
 1. January 16, 1987 - The Arts and Sciences Curriculum Committee has approved the elimination of PHS 3950, Energy Science. The course was part of the Energy Management Program and is no longer taught. I hereby approve the elimination of this course by executive action.
 2. January 16, 1987 - According to CAA guidelines adopted October 22, 1981 (81-35) whereby CAA appoints members to the Honors Council based on a list submitted by the Vice President for Academic Affairs in consultation with the Director of the Honors Programs, I request that CAA approve the temporary appointment of Dr. Kathlene Shank to replace Dr. Patricia McAlister while she is on sabbatical leave during the spring semester.
- V. BS in Geology - Status Quo* (Agenda Item 87-1)
Dr. Gary Wallace, Chair, and Dr. Alan Baharlou of the Department of Geology/Geography made a presentation concerning the status of the Geology program. The presentation was followed by discussion with Council members. Dr. McGown moved and Dr. J. Ivarie seconded the motion to remove the * designation from the BS in Geology. Motion passed unanimously.
- VI. B of Music - Performance Option - Status Quo* (Agenda Item 87-1)
Dr. Felstehausen moved and Dr. E. Keiter seconded the motion to remove the * designation from the B of Music - Performance Option. Motion passed unanimously.

- VII. The Council unanimously approved Agenda Item 87-1 with modifications as specified.
- VIII. Vice President Schick shared information he had gained from recent meetings with the Council concerning Provisional Admissions. Discussion followed.
- IX. Dr. Baumgardner informed Council members that interviews would be beginning soon with VPAA candidates and asked that they attend interview sessions.
