I. Minutes:

In the Minutes of September 10, the description of MAT 3520 should be corrected as follows:

New Course, MAT 3520, Teaching Mathematics in Grades K-6 - (87-32)

This action approved the following to become effective Fall 1988:

MAT 3520, Teaching Mathematics in grades K-6, (1-1-1), F.S.

Prerequisite: Mathematics 3420, or satisfactory score on IMPT1 and IMPT2, and concurrent or prior registration in ELE 3240, or permission of the instructor.

Item VI, THA 3075, Acting With a Dialect, should be corrected as follows:

Proposed New Course, THA 3075, Acting With a Dialect - (87-40)

Proposed New Course, PLS 2511, Mock Trial (87-39)

 Prerequisites: HEC 2800 and HST 4800 or permission of the instructor.
