3. From Lewis Coon: a report about neighboring universities with longer summer terms than Eastern's. He suggests "that our faculty move to the UNI/CSU academic year schedule with more people employed for the additional graduate summer term."
4. From Frank McCormick: two books requested by the English Department well in advance of the Textbook Library's request have arrived late with some shortages still. "At least in these two cases the Textbook Library is not functioning efficiently."
5. (copy) From Ken Hesler to President Marvin: the problem of funding the Distinguished Faculty Award is to be presented to the Foundation Board on October 7.
6. From President Marvin:

"In the next few days, Dr. Donald Walters, Executive Director of the Board of Governors, will be sending you a proposal on Tax Sheltered Annuities which was

presented to the Board of Governors on a first-reading basis at its meeting today." The Faculty is to respond to the proposals.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. The subject of President Marvin dropping further action about the reduction of work for administrators to enlarge summer school offerings was discussed. The sentiment of the Senate members ranged from disappointment and discouragement to frustration and anger. The summer school committee (Scott Smith and Ken Sutton) is studying further avenues about the problem.
