

Bob Bennett, Child Protection Supervisor for the Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS), will present "Legalities, Realities and DCFS." Bennett will focus on the legal role of DCFS personnel in investigating abuse, sexual abuse and neglect in relation to schools. He is an experienced presenter noted for poignantly addressing critical issues and questions.

Illinois State Trooper Bill Rogers and his canine partner will discuss procedures for using the Illinois State Police (I.S.P.) in drug searches. His presentation, entitled "Dogs, Drugs and the Law," will also provide a demonstration.

Alan Price, Principal of Oblong High School, will present "Ritualistic Crime." His authority concerning cults and ritualistic crime is well-noted in the educational field.
