CHARLESTON, IL--Four productions remain on the Eastern Illinois University Theatre's 1986-87 schedule.

"Merton of the Movies," dramatized by George S. Kaufman and Marc Connelly, is scheduled for Oct. 10, 11, 13 and 14 at 8 p.m. and at 2 p.m. on Oct. 12. The play is described as "a picture of American youth, and an interesting commentary on motion pictures."

"Hedda Gabler" will be presented on Nov. 20, 21, 22 and 24 at 8 p.m. and at 2 p.m. on Nov. 23. Written by Henrik Ibsen, the play depicts a heroine who refuses to face life and is trapped by her own instability and the irony of circumstances.

Neil Simon's "The Good Doctor" will be staged by Interpreter's Theatre on Feb. 20, 21, 23 and 24 at 8 p.m. and at 2 p.m. on Feb. 22. This production is Simon's adaptation of stories by Anton Chekhov.

"The Skin of our Teeth," the Pulitzer Prize-winner by Thornton Wilder, is scheduled for April 17, 18, 26 and 27 at 8 p.m. and on April 19 at 2 p.m.
