OLD BUSINESS:

Gabbard moved and Smith seconded that the motion eliminating petitions for faculty elections be removed from the table. Motion carried. One of the main arguments posed by Senators against petitions was that each year not enough candidates petition to run for the various committees. As a result, the Nominating Committee has had to call people to run without petitions. This is not a function of the committee. Also, it was pointed out that some areas in the university seem not interested enough to sponsor candidates, therefore, these areas go unrepresented. As a result of this situation, the Senate wishes to run an analysis of the current elections. When the motion came to vote, it failed.

Stoner moved, seconded by Sullivan, that the Senate go into Executive Session. Motion carried.
