2. Chair Hamand reported about the BOG meeting held March 30 and 31 in Springfield. Unanimous gloom pervaded.

OLD BUSINESS:

Jacobs moved, seconded by Goodrick, to remove the motion to abolish the Faculty Senate from the table. Twelve Senators voted to retain the Senate, one voted to abolish it, and one abstained.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Budget cut: Goodrick moved, Lynch seconded, a resolution of protest regarding the selective austerity of the Governor's proposed FY 83 budget. Of all the state employees, only University Personnel have been singled out for a salary freeze. Data relative to this proposal will be presented next week.
2. Stoner moved, seconded by Sullivan, that beginning Spring 1982 the officers of the Faculty Senate be elected at the last meeting in the Spring semester by the current Senate. LeDuc moved, seconded by Floyd, to table the motion until the next meeting. The motion passed.

The meeting adjourned at 3:20 p.m.
