COMMUNICATIONS:

1. From Lucy Gabbard:

I wish to express my opposition to Dr. Coon's recommendation that the names of our Schools be changed to Colleges. Considering the gap in size between a School of three departments and the 17 departments of the College of Arts and Sciences, such a change appears to be an unnecessary inflation in rank--especially for no greater cause than that "Some individuals believe a college is a higher administrative unit than a school ... and thus a more prestigious place for faculty members to teach."

2. From President Marvin:

- A. A copy of the report from the Ad Hoc Committee on Registration and a copy of his response to the recommendation of the committee.
- B. A copy of addendum to the report of EIU to the BOG, May 6, 1982.

3. From Donald Walters: A proposed amendment to the Board Regulations raising travel allocations to Chicago, Washington, D.C., and New York City.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. The Faculty Senate unanimously voted to present a Lynn Trank print of Old Main to Diane Bartus, the excellent student secretary of the Senate, who is graduating.
- 2. Sutton moved, seconded by Jacobs, that the Faculty Senate receive the Studies Abroad Committee as one of its standing committees. LeDuc moved, seconded by Preston, to table the motion until the first summer meeting of the Senate. The motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS:

Ms. Tolle and Ms. Kelly reported that there was some misunderstanding about their efforts to preserve the Paul Sargent Gallery. They reported that, primarily, they wanted to have the name designated to an area where Sargent's paintings and other artists' work could be shown as in the past. Also, they wanted Sargent's paintings preserved and cared for in the new facilities in the Tarble Arts Center.

REPORTS:

Senator Floyd reported about the meeting of the BOG, May 5 and 6, at Springfield. He said it came as a shock that approximately 90 new programs in the system were squashed. He also commented that he was impressed with the EIU students in attendance at the meeting because of their excellent participation.
