CHARLESTON, IL--The Eastern Illinois University Jazz Ensembles will present an Evening of Big Band Music of the 1940's" on Thursday, Nov. 21 at 7:30 p.m. in Dvorak Concert Hall.

The program will feature the EIU Jazz Ensemble, conducted by Allan Horney, and the Lab Band, conducted by Jeff Anderson, graduate assistant in jazz studies.

The nostalgia concert, the first ever presented by the jazz department, will feature hits of the Glenn Miller, Tommy Dorsey, Benny Goodman, Count Basie, and Duke Ellington bands.

In addition to big band standards like "Pennsylvania 6-500," "In the Mood," and "Sing, Sing, Sing," several guest singers will perform ballads, such as "At Last" and "In a Sentimental Mood."

Highlight of the evening will be a segment featuring music by the Modernaires, the vocal group of the Glenn Miller Orchestra. Other big band hits to be performed include: "Leap Frog" by Les Brown, "Marie" by Tommy Dorsey, and "April in Paris" by Count Basie.

Admission is \$2 for adults, \$1 for students and senior citizens.
