## COMMUNICATIONS:

1. From President Marvin to Chair Lynch:

"Thank you for sending the Senate's recommendation to add the title 'Provost' to the Vice President for Academic Affairs. Frankly, I have considered making the change and will pursue it more vigorously now."

2. From President Marvin to Chair Lynch:

"...I do not intend to consider any request for the naming of a facility without having a specific set of guidelines established."  
"I continue to believe that a set of guidelines is imperative, and would appreciate having a proposal from the Faculty Senate...I would suggest that the Senate identify two or three individuals who could serve on a committee with Vice President Rives and Mr. Hesler. That committee would produce criteria which could then be reviewed by the Senate for their reaction, and finally by me for approval."

3. From President Marvin to Chair Lynch:

"I am approving the following budget for the Faculty Senate for FY83:

5. From Charles Switzer in a telephone conversation with Chair Lynch about summer faculty staffing:

"Soderberg checked with the chief negotiator for the Board who felt that since the issue of ten-month contract is now on the table the information we requested should not be divulged by Switzer at this time."

Scott Smith, Sue Stoner and Jeff Lynch were appointed to serve on the committee for recommending the policy for the naming of facilities on campus.
