CHARLESTON, IL--Diane Atkins, whose father Mr. Roger Ott lives in Charleston, and Amy Parcels, whose parents Mr. and Mrs. Frank Parcels also live in Charleston, have been initiated into Phi Alpha Eta, freshman women's honorary society, at Eastern Illinois University.

Phi Alpha Eta was established at Eastern in 1967 to recognize academic achievement during the freshman year. To be eligible for membership a student must have at least a 3.5 cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 scale after 26-40 semester hours are completed.
