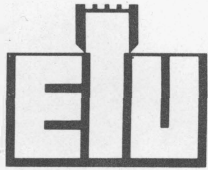

CHARLESTON, IL--Three local students were recently initiated into Phi Alpha Eta women's academic honorary sorority at Eastern Illinois University. They are Courtney Rosen, daughter of Michael and Sue Ann Rosen of Midlothian; Sarah Feinstein, daughter of Joan and Joel Feinstein of Homewood; and Susan Jurges, daughter of Albert and Barbara Jurges of Tinley Park.

To be selected a member of Phi Alpha Eta, students must achieve and maintain at least a 3.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale during their first two semesters at the university.

A 1992 graduate of Bremen High School, Rosen is a sophomore majoring in political science at Eastern.

Feinstein, a 1992 graduate of Homewood-Flossmoor High School, is a sophomore majoring in family services at Eastern.
