OLD BUSINESS:

1. Sutton moved, seconded by Smith, to remove the by-laws from the table. Smith moved, seconded by Heumann, to approve the revised by-laws for the Faculty Senate. Motion carried.

SPRING ELECTIONS:

In mid-March, the Faculty Senate will conduct elections for membership on the Council of Faculties, Faculty Senate, University Personnel Committee, Council on Academic Affairs, Council on Teacher Education, and Council on Graduate Studies. For convenience, all of the above are designated herein as Councils.

To be nominated for membership on a council, a faculty member must submit or have submitted for him/her an individual petition containing the signature of ten eligible faculty. All petitions must be received by the Chairperson of the Nominations Committee, John LeDuc, no later than Thursday, February 24, 1983, at noon. The election dates are March 15 and 16, and the run-off election is scheduled for Thursday, April 7, 1983. Arrangements for absentee ballots will be announced prior to each election.

A faculty member who accepts nomination for one major council shall be ineligible for nomination to any other major council for this election. Current members of major councils are not eligible for nomination to any other major council unless their terms expire this semester.

Nominators of candidates for area representation (Council on Teacher Education, Council on Graduate Studies, and University Personnel Committee) must themselves serve in the same areas as the candidates that they nominate. Nominators and nominees for the Council on Graduate Studies must be members of the graduate faculty.

As specified by the Constitution of the Council of Faculties, the following may neither be nominators nor nominees of the Council of Faculties: President, Vice Presidents, Deans, Directors, Associate and Assistant Deans or Directors, Registrars, Business Managers, Executive Assistants, Department Heads, Division Chairpersons or Heads.

In the event that a minimum of two nominees for each available council position is not met by the petition method, the Faculty Senate will, by a majority vote, nominate a sufficient number of additional candidates to meet that minimum.

Once again candidates for the various University Councils will be asked to write brief replies to questions concerning council issues. The questions will be prepared by the Elections Committee of the Senate based on material furnished by the Executive Committees of each

council. The candidates' replies will be distributed to the faculty prior to the election. The questions to be answered will be sent to all candidates shortly after petitions are received.
