NOMINATIONS REPORT:

Floyd moved, seconded by LeDuc, to elect Carol Stevens as the Senate's representative on the Search Committee for the Director of Financial Aids. Motion passed unanimously. An up-dated list of committees was presented. See attachment.

1. Carol Stevens, Lewis Coon, and Scott Smith will meet with Sam Taber to gather information concerning the length of the school calendar year.
2. Stevens moved, seconded by Sullivan, to accept the following corrections to the by-laws and to date them November 15, 1983. Motion passed unanimously.

II. Membership and Duties of the Senate's Standing Committees:

A. NOMINATIONS:

5. The Nominations Committee shall be responsible for the nomination of ~~bergaining unit~~ faculty members for the following Faculty Committees and Student-Faculty Boards: Apportionment Board, Council of Faculties, Financial Grants, Health Service, Insurance Committe, Inter-collegiate Athletics Board, Publications Board, Sports and Recreation Board, Traffic and Safety Board, and the Council on University Planning and Budget.

## B. ELECTIONS:

will be composed

1. The Elections Committee ~~shall be comprised~~ of three members.
2. Annual elections shall be conducted each spring semester for membership on the University Personnel Committee, Faculty Senate, Academic Program Elimination Review Committee, Council on Academic Affairs, Council on Teacher Education, Council on Graduate Studies, Council of Faculties, and Council on Faculty Research.
8. Filling of Vacancies:
  - b. Vacancies on the major committees of the Senate, except Council on Faculty Research, shall be filled in like manner as in section 8.a., the list of alternates varying with the number of positions originally to be filled.
3. Coon moved, seconded by Floyd, that the Insurance Committee be disbanded. Nine votes for, 5 against. The motion passed.

## DISCUSSION OF REGISTRATION:

Mike Taylor, Dave Sardella and John Cole presented information about the drop-add processes and a new technique for spring registration. A Special Alternate Course Request card will be offered to each student on which he/she can list a department course number and a related primary course. This will further his chances of getting a maximum load of 16 hours.

Mike Taylor asked that the Faculty Senate encourage the faculty advisors to inform students about the Request card. (The Eastern News of November 16 carried an informative article about the process.)

The meeting adjourned at 4:15. The next meeting of the Faculty Senate will be on November 29 at 2:15 in the Martinsville Room.
