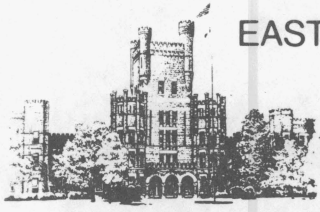

SUMMER WORKSHOPS STILL OPEN

CHARLESTON, IL.--There's still time to register for Eastern Illinois University's School of Adult and Continuing Education Summer of Excellence short-term classes for youth ages 8 and up.

Five classes in the Summer of Excellence program remain open, including "Paper Jewelry," "Poetry: An Image," "Computer Programming for Kids," "Advanced Topics in Model Rockets," and "Future Entrepreneurs."

SUMMER WORKSHOPS

"Paper Jewelry" is offered from 9 to 10 a.m., July 9-19, and offers participants ages 8 and up an opportunity to learn how to make a variety of paper jewelry, from water color earrings and twisted paper pins to collage jewelry. The course fee is \$32, plus a \$5 materials fee.

"Poetry: An Image," designed for students ages 8-11, meets from 9 to 10 a.m., July 9-19, and deals with using the basic language as a way to construct an image and incorporates word games into the sessions. The course fee is \$32, plus a \$2 materials fee.

While learning to program in BASIC, the "Computer Programming for Kids" workshop will enhance students' thinking, learning, and creative skills necessary for solving problems. Designed for youths ages 9-15, the workshop meets from 12:30 to 2:30 p.m., July 9-19, and costs \$64, plus a \$5 materials fee.

Designing, building and launching model rockets safely and successfully will be the focus of an "Advanced Topics in Model Rockets," workshop that meets from 1:30 to 3 p.m., July 9-19, for participants ages 9 and up. The course fee is \$48, plus a \$10 materials fee.

"Future Entrepreneurs," tailored to participants ages 10-13, will enable enrollees to develop, market, advertise and sell a product of their choice. The principles and concepts of operating a small business will be discussed and applied. Tours of area businesses will also be given. The course meets from 1:30 to 3:30 p.m., July 9-19. Registration is \$64, plus a \$5 materials fee.
